



JULIAN SINCLAIR SMITH CELEBRATION OF LEARNING AWARD NOMINATION FORM

Julian Sinclair Smith believed learning was a lifelong endeavor. His quest for knowledge, both formal and informal, spanned the disciplines of electrical, sound and aerospace engineering. For his pioneering work in the emerging technology of ultrahigh frequency (UHF) television, Julian Sinclair Smith was considered a pioneer in the world of broadcasting. He was the owner of local station WTTE FOX28 and founded the company that now owns WSYX ABC 6 and WWHO CW Columbus. After he lost his fight with Parkinson's Disease in 1993, his family chose to honor his passion for reading, education and lifelong learning with a gift to the Columbus Metropolitan Library Foundation in his memory.
